## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE FOR THE MELCHSEE-FRUTT ROPE PARK

The undersigned (*parent/guardian\**) hereby confirms that the following named children or adolescents (up to the age of 18) may visit the adventure and theme park at Melchsee-Frutt in Melchtal.

The undersigned further confirms that they have been informed of the risks associated with visiting the park and have read, understood, and accepted the general terms and conditions of business. In addition, all users must be informed of the potential risks before embarking on the course and must confirm in writing that they are aware of these risks and agree to them.

*\*the following persons are considered as guardians: parents, teachers, legal guardians*

### GENERAL

At all times during the rope park visit, each user must be within sight of an employee or an adult.

### CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

Pfideris from **4 to 8 years (recommended)** must be supervised from the ground by an adult. In an emergency, this supervisor must raise the alarm by calling out.

Children aged **6 to 9 years (minimum height of 120 cm)** must be accompanied by an adult on the course. We recommend one adult per two children.

Children aged **10 to 13 years** must be accompanied by an adult or supervised from the ground. We recommend one adult per ten children.

For adolescents aged **14 to 17 years**, discOWer GmbH assumes that their legal guardians have agreed to the use of the Melchsee-Frutt rope park.

### RISK WARNING

Walking the course involves certain risks. Clothes can become dirty or damaged, and falls can result in cuts or pressure sores from the climbing harnesses. Visitors to the park must always secure themselves with carabiners and, if necessary, with zipline pulleys; otherwise, they risk falling and, in extreme cases, death. By strictly following the park rules, these risks can be minimized.

The facility is not monitored; the rope park employees have only instructional, supervisory, and assistance functions. Visitors walk the course independently and at their own risk and responsibility.

### HEALTH

The rope park is open to users who are not suffering from any illness or mental or physical impairment that could pose a risk to their own health or the health of others when walking the course. People under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or **strong** medication are not allowed to use the rope park. The maximum user weight is 120 kg.

### OBJECTS

No objects may be carried that could pose a risk to the user or others (jewellery, mobile phones, cameras, etc.). Loose clothing and long hair must be secured.

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### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Before use, the entire theoretical and practical safety instruction must be attended. Any uncertainties in the instruction must be addressed and clarified by the user. All instructions and decisions of the rope park employees are binding. Users may be excluded for violations or breaches of safety requirements.

### RENTAL EQUIPMENT

Rental equipment such as helmets, climbing harnesses, etc. must be used strictly in accordance with guidelines/instructions and must be returned without request at the end of the usage period. Any damage to the equipment must be reported to the rope park employees.

### DUTY OF CARE

It is not permitted to throw objects or any form of waste on the ground; please use the designated waste bins. Only walk on the designated paths in the forest to protect young trees, forest animals, and moss. Smoking, eating, and drinking on the courses are strictly prohibited.

### DURATION OF STAY

The stay in the Pfideripark is limited to 1.5 hours, in the rope park to 3 hours (additional payment required). In the event of force majeure leading to the closure of the rope park by rope park staff, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entrance fee.

### WEBCAM IMAGES IN THE ROPE PARK

A webcam has been installed in the rope park area, which captures images of the 'Rägämettel' course at regular intervals (approximately every 10 minutes) whilst the park is open. The images are used solely to illustrate the current situation and atmosphere in the rope park, as well as for informational and promotional purposes.

The images are not permanently stored, archived or passed on to third parties. No personal analysis or identification of the people depicted takes place. The recordings are automatically overwritten or deleted after each update.

By entering the rope park, visitors acknowledge this notice. Anyone who does not wish to appear in the images should avoid the 'Rägämettel' course. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the staff at any time.

### LIABILITY – INSURANCE

The Seilpark Melchsee-Frutt disclaims all liability for any damages that may arise in direct or indirect connection with the use of the rope park. The Seilpark Melchsee-Frutt specifically disclaims liability if these terms of use are disregarded, circumvented or violated.

Insurance is the responsibility of the users.

### JURISDICTION

The place of jurisdiction is Obwalden. Swiss law exclusively applies.
